DESCRIPTION

Lutheran Northwest is a college preparatory high school, grades 9-12, located in Rochester Hills, Michigan. Established in 1978, Lutheran Northwest has offered a tradition of quality educational programs, an excellent faculty, and abundant student leadership opportunities.

CURRICULUM

The academic program is a college-prep curriculum organized on a semester-based, eight-period daily schedule. All students take seven or eight credits per year. Class periods meet for 45 minutes each day.

- **Honors classes** are offered in Advanced Algebra, Anatomy & Physiology, Chemistry, English 10, Physics, and Theology.
- **AP courses** are offered in Biology, Calculus, English Language, English Literature, Government, Physics, and U.S. History.

RANK

Rank in class includes all semester grades from all courses for grades 9-12. The ranking is based on the weighted cumulative GPA. Honors courses will be weighted an additional 0.5 (i.e. A is worth 4.5, B is worth 3.5, etc.), and Advanced Placement courses will be weighted an additional 1.0 (i.e. A is worth 5.0, B is worth 4.0, etc.).
