Daily Experiences

Basics in Video Whiteboarding

Students will enter the week in a fun and engaging creative session in teams. These teams will strategize and begin to learn and build out the foundation story board for their excitement for the week. Day 1 will consist of hands-on introductions to the studio and creative areas to design their show.

Setting the Stage
